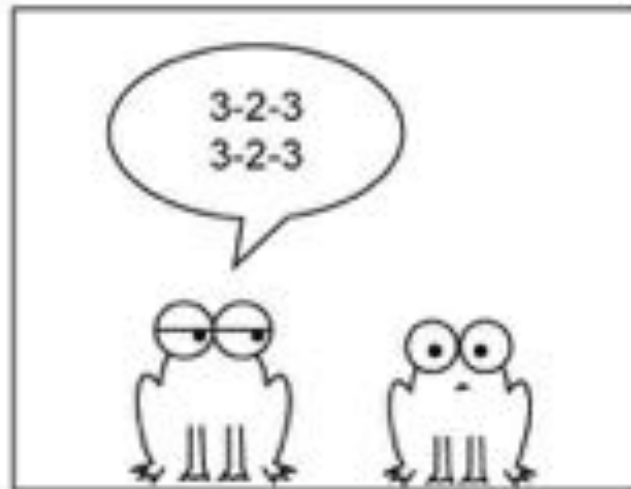
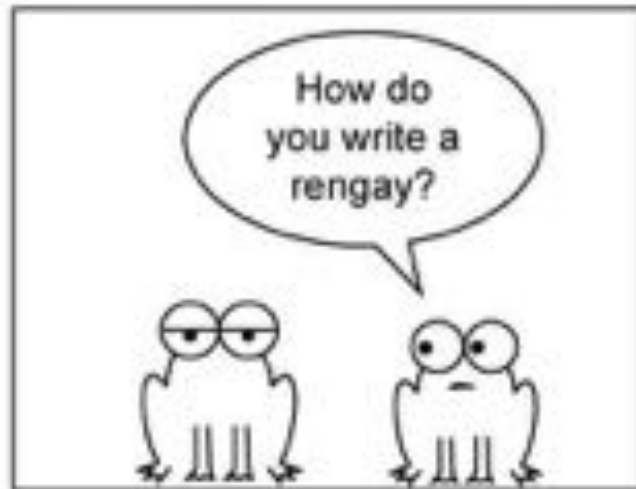

RENGAY — A HISTORY

- Garry Gay (USA) invented the rengay form in 1992
- Renga/renku vs. rengay
- First rengay 'Deep Winter' (Aug 1992)
- First published rengay – 'Between Storms' (published in Albatross, volume II, number 2 in 1993)

MY FIRST 3-PERSON RENGAY WITH GARRY GAY & JOHN THOMPSON

So how do we write a rengay?

- 2, 3 or even 6 poets take turns writing
- Rengay = a poetic conversation
- Structure: (A, B, C = Poets)
 - 2-person rengay: 3A-2B-3A-3B-2A-3B
(number of lines per haiku, not syllables)
 - 3-person rengay: 3A-2B-3C-2A-3B-2C OR
3A-2B-3C-3A-2C-3B OR 3A-2B-3C-3B-2A-3C
 - If writing with 3 or 6 people, initials needs to be shown at the end of each verse

 - Extra: avoid word repetition/closing verse should connect with verses 5 & 1/alternative rule for 3-people: 3-2-3-3-2-3 with **ABCACB** or **ABCBAC**

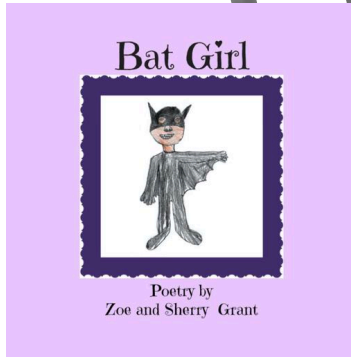
