Hotels- *It will be important to book hotels as soon as possible* as Portland is a tourist destination in the summer. Myrna Begin has compiled a detailed list of hotels close to the meeting location, transportation information, and costs - to request the list, send an email to Shelley or go to the HSA Oregon Link http://www.hsa-haiku.org/regions/Oregon.htm . Bed and Breakfast places are also abundant.

Parking - In downtown Portland, there are many parking structures; best to ask your hotel staff where the closest one is to your hotel and for a street car schedule. You can use the "NS" Line to get to the meeting locations, or at the Ramona House, it is mostly metered street parking, and it may require you to move your car after a couple of hours in one spot. There is also a Parking Structure/building near Ramona House called "Parking Compliance Service" located at 1551 NW Quimby St. Parking in the structures runs from \$8-\$14 per day.

Transportation -If you are staying in downtown Portland, it is best to use the "NS "Line Street car for transportation to meeting location & restaurants (the "NS" streetcar makes a loop around the center of Portland- the Ramona house is 3 blocks North of the stop at 14th & Northrup). Tickets can be purchased via credit card (\$2-\$3) at terminals located next to the stops or on the street car. Look on the Tri-Met Website for schedules:

http://portlandstreetcar.org/node/4, or just go to a stop- Average wait is 15 mins. The Airport is serviced by a MAX train to downtown Portland (west side) and some east side hotels (the Willamette River divides the 2 sides).

We are planning to car pool for the Sunday Japanese Garden Tour -let Shelley know if you will want a ride from your hotel.
